What does Parental involvement look like across the phases?

Whole school

Reading Support:

Across the whole school parents are involved in supporting children with reading, in FS2 and Key Stage 1 parents are welcomed into school to listen to individual children read. In Y3/4 parents are involved in Reading Matters, again supporting targeted individuals with their reading.

Numeracy:

Parents are provided with booklets regarding curricular targets for their child's age/phase on a termly basis.

Whole School Events:

The school hosts several events each year to which all parents are invited. These have included:

- Diamond Jubilee family celebratory picnic
- Sports Day
- Celebration of Work Afternoon
- Spring time Musical Showcase
- Christmas and end of year concerts

Foundation Stage

Within Foundation Stage parents are invited in to share in their child's learning throughout the year.

This starts from when a child is offered a place at the school, parents are invited to join their children for a 'transition picnic', giving them opportunity to meet staff, current pupils and parents. There are also meetings for parents to meet with staff on a 1:1 basis to share any issues or concerns that they may have regarding their child starting school.

Once a child has started school parents have the opportunity to attend a parents evening within the first term. They also receive written reports on their child's progress each term.

At the end of each half term the Foundation Stage staff send out a Progress Review sheet to parents asking them for comments on their child's learning and these are used to inform the planning for the following term.

Specific Foundation Stage events have included:

- Pizza making.
- Betty's Tea Room
- Christmas Craft Workshop
- Easter Coffee Afternoon

Key Stage 1

Within Key Stage 1 parents are invited in to support classroom learning, and on out of school learning opportunities such as trips and visits.

The Year 1 classes display photographs of learning that has taken place in the classroom in a "what's happened this week" board.

Key Stage 1 holds enterprise events and invites parents in to participate in activities led by the children.

Key Stage 2

Key Stage 2 hold enterprise events that have been planned by the children.

Parents are invited in to meetings across the year where they receive information on SATs preparation, PGL, Castleton, Whirlow visits. The staff also give parents the opportunity to come into school and view photographs and videos of these activities.
