

## Parental Engagement at Oughtibridge School

At Oughtibridge Primary School we believe that parents play a vital role in the education of their children. When parents are engaged and involved there is a benefit to all those within our school and the community.

Parental engagement has a positive impact on the achievement of our pupils, we aim to provide an environment in which children are supported and inspired to learn and in which parents are welcomed as partners in their child's learning.

As children move between Year groups and across Key Stages of the school, we hold transition meetings for parents informing them about the curriculum that is taught as well as informing them about expectations, homework and residential visits that take place in that phase.

There are many events that take place across the school that involve parents in their child's learning. Each year group holds an annual enterprise event that children are instrumental in planning and delivering.



There are regular opportunities for parents to come into school and share stories with their child or groups of children. We also hold Maths game sessions to help children develop a range of number skills as well as turn taking and sharing.



We hold workshops to give our parents a 'hands on' experiences of their child's curriculum. In the past, workshops have given the parents opportunity to experience Phonics teaching, ICT lessons, Numeracy in Key Stage 1, forest school sessions as well as helping parents to prepare their child for the Y6 SAT's tests.
