

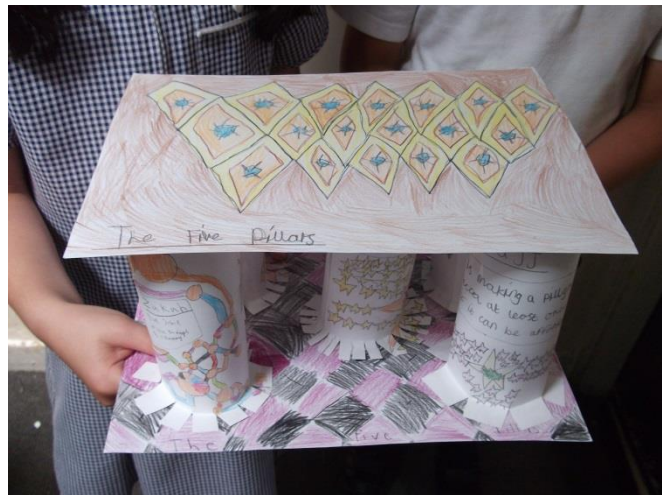
## R.E. at Oughtibridge Primary School

R.E. is taught across the school and our Schemes of Work are based on the Sheffield Agreed Syllabus for R.E. In line with the Agreed Syllabus 51% of the R.E. curriculum content is Christian based and the rest is devoted to learning about the other main world faiths (Judaism, Sikhism, Buddhism, Islam and Hinduism).

In some year groups R.E. is taught as a weekly lesson and in other year groups it is taught as a mini topic.

In R.E. the children learn about the stories, customs, practices and festivals related to the religion being studied. This can take the form of discussion, drama, role play and writing. The children are encouraged to use their knowledge and understanding of the R.E. studied to have a positive impact on their own lives.

Children are encouraged to develop their P4C (Philosophy for Children) skills in RE lessons. In P4C the children learn through asking more and better questions. This improves the children's listening, speaking and talking skills.
