



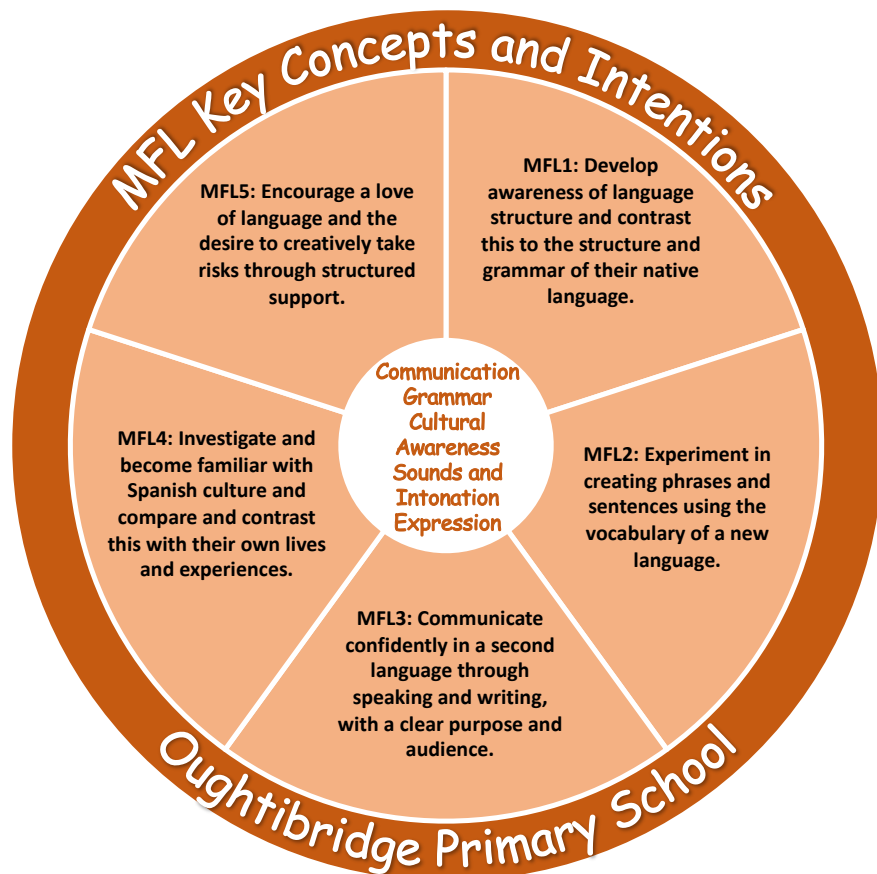

Year 3	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes begin to engage in conversations <p>Aims: To understand basic Spanish greetings and words (e.g. expressing feelings, numbers to 10, colour names, basic classroom instructions, days of the week). To listen to, learn and respond to Spanish rhymes, songs and stories and write a new version of a familiar story in Spanish.</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> engage in conversations and answer questions speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures develop accurate pronunciation and intonation and present ideas orally read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing, including an understanding of basic grammar (masculine/feminine) <p>Aims: To know the names of some animals in Spanish and begin to use adjectives to describe them. To be able to write basic Spanish sentences with the understanding that some words change depending on if the word is masculine or feminine. To extend knowledge of Spanish numbers to 31 and beyond and develop a basic vocabulary using nouns and adjectives.</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> extend vocabulary and develop an ability to understand new words write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences <p>Aims: To understand the names for some Spanish shapes, numbers and colours, using adjectives to describe them. To understand the names of some Spanish foods and express opinions about them. To perform songs with actions and read simple stories in Spanish.</p>

<p>Year 4</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding • explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words • engage in conversations <p>Aim: to know the months of the year, numbers to 31, write the date, know how to ask and answer questions (e.g. about birthdays) in Spanish.</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ask and answer questions • speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures • develop accurate pronunciation and intonation <p>Aim: to be able to shop for fruit using greetings and phrases (speaking and listening).</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences • describe people • read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing • extend vocabulary and develop an ability to understand new words <p>Aim: to be able to read a description of a monster and write a description using a writing frame (reading and writing).</p>
<p>Year 5</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • broaden vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new Spanish words that introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary • in Spanish, describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing • understand basic grammar (feminine and masculine) <p>Aim: to talk about family in Spanish (speaking, reading and writing sentences).</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • present ideas and information orally in Spanish to a range of audiences • speak in sentences, using familiar Spanish vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures • explore the patterns and sounds of the Spanish language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words. <p>Aim: to be able to describe the weather in Spanish and to compare the weather in two different places (speaking and writing).</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • present ideas and information orally and in Spanish, to a range of audiences • understand basic Spanish grammar (e.g. noun and adjective agreement) <p>Aim: to describe, in Spanish, clothing for school and leisure (speaking and writing).</p>
<p>Year 6</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • read carefully and show understanding of Spanish words, phrases and simple writing • speak in sentences, using familiar Spanish vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures • appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in Spanish <p>Aim: to be able to talk, read and speak about my own hobbies in Spanish.</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • listen attentively to spoken language in Spanish and show understanding by joining in and responding • engage in conversations in Spanish, ask and answer questions, express opinions and respond to those of others, seeking clarification and help • describe (in Spanish) people, places, things and actions orally and in writing <p>Aim: to be able to discuss and write about a pet in Spanish.</p>	<p>Children will learn to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new Spanish words that are introduced into familiar written material, including through using a dictionary • read carefully and show understanding of Spanish words, phrases and simple writing • understand basic Spanish grammar <p>Aim: to discuss and write about our home in Spanish.</p>
