Y2 had a great time at Magna before half term. We learned lots about different materials, and even took part in the Kitchen Sink Show!



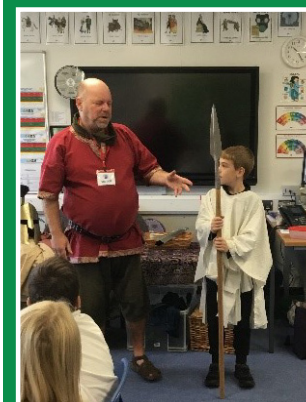
Y2 Marvellous Maths

Year 2 have loved our maths investigations this year! We've used all sorts of equipment to develop our understanding of place value, addition and subtraction, and shape!



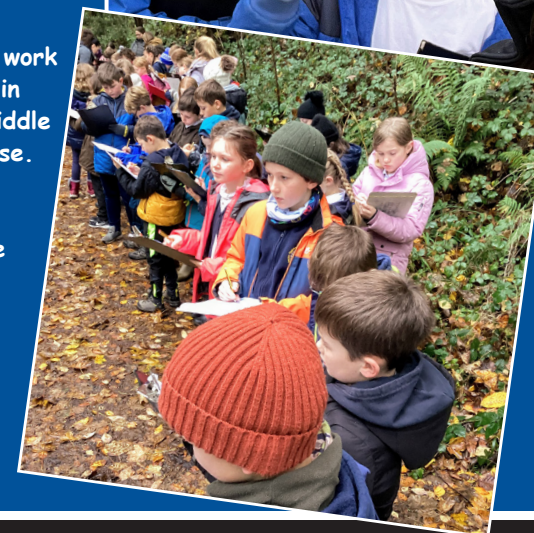
Y4 Greek Day
