SOS have been busy organising in the background, and it is our hope that the event with help to raise funds towards upgrading the AV equipment in Coumes Hall (to complement the new remote-controlled blinds) and some new Woods of Wonder equipment!!

If you can join us – there is lots instore. Here is some useful information.

School can be accessed from the main gate on **Naylor Road**, or from the **Footgate** entrance from **1pm**. There will be no parking on the school site as this is being used by the stallholders but please be courteous to our neighbours if parking on the street.

The event will be a **cash** event, though we will also have our **SUM-UP Card Machine** and **QR codes**, so that funds can be paid via STRIPE. Parents will be able to purchase **raffle tickets** for children to then use as tokens on the games equivalent to £1.

Tickets will be available from the **outside of the Year 4 classrooms near to the school field** (SUM-UP Machine/Cash) and from the **SOS Refreshments stall in the Dining Pod** (QR Codes/ Cash), which will also be the meeting points in case anyone gets separated. There will also be a meeting point near to the outdoor classroom where this year we have **Hair Braiding**, by **Twenty-Two Hair and Beauty**, in addition to **Face Painting** by **Giuliana** located in the car park.
