Dear Parents and Carers

Our LINKS Partnership is organising a **Ball Skills Festival for KS1 children** to be held on **Monday 13th October**, at Bradfield Secondary School. This is the first festival of the academic year for our KS1 children and an exciting opportunity for our children to use the facilities at Bradfield School. We are pleased to be able to offer our children the chance to take part. The opportunity is initially being offered only to Year 1 pupils as places at the event are limited. In the event that we have spare spaces after the initial deadline, this event may be extended to Year 2 pupils. Where possible, we will endeavour to offer extra-curricular sporting opportunities to all children over the course of the academic year.

The children will need to be transported there and we are asking for your support in taking your child to and from the event. Parents may wish to collaborate and agree to take children other than their own, but we would ask that this is organised between yourselves.

Parents/carers are welcome to stay and spectate at this event if they like, or can be dropped off and collected. In either situation, children should make themselves known to Miss Calderbank at the start of the event. If you are not staying at Bradfield with us, we ask that children are collected promptly at 4.40pm. Children will need their school PE kit, including trainers and a named plastic bottle of water.

The main aim of the evening is to experience a variety of sporting skills in a fun and friendly environment. The Y10 Sports Leaders from Bradfield School will be helping Bradley Stratton from LINKS to deliver the festival. It will also give the children the opportunity to meet KS1 children from other schools in Peak Edge Academy Trust and have a fantastic time. There could be photographers at the event, who may use pictures of the children in promotional material.
