Ways to ask your child about their day at school

- What made you smile today?
- What made you laugh today?
- Who did you play with today?
- Tell me one thing you learnt today?
- What are you looking forward to, tomorrow?
- What did you find hard today?
- What were you proud of today?
- What was the best part of your day?

Why are these questions better than 'how was your day at school'?

These questions are open ended and will encourage your child to give a more detailed answer, rather than a one word answer.

It is also a great way of understanding your child's feelings, emotions and gives you a great insight to their school life.

Don't ask all the questions at once and it's ok if they say nothing or don't know they answer.
