You may have already heard from the children that we have been doing lots of work on our topic 'Super Sheffield'.

In order to give the children the opportunity to discover the history of Sheffield we have arranged an exciting visit to Magna Science Museum. Once at the museum the children will explore the museum, looking at the big melt and also take part in an exciting workshop called 'living steel' run by the museum's education team.

Using storytelling, object handling and exploration, children will learn about Sheffield's industrial history and why it became known as the 'steel city'. They will explore how the Templeborough steelworks has changed over the years, find out about forging, casting and the vital role steel plays in today's world.

We would welcome adults to supervise small groups of children on the visit. If you would like to join us, please contact your child's class teacher on dojo. There are limited spaces on the coach for helpers so we will let you know if you will be needed.

The visit for all year 1 children will be on Thursday 20th November 2025. We will leave school at 9am and return before the end of the school day.
