Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our 'Rainforest Calling' topic next term, we are very excited to be going on a trip to Tropical World in Leeds. This trip will take place on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January and will be all day. The children will need to be **dropped off at school by 08.20** and **we will return to school at the later time of 3.45pm**. Please collect your child from their classroom door as normal.

Tropical World is situated near Roundhay Park in Leeds. It is home to a remarkable variety of Rainforest animals, birds and fish and allows the children to explore the habitats of the tropics and come face to face with some of the amazing creatures that live in the Tropical world. The children will also participate in the 'Eat to be Eaten' workshop, led by the staff at Tropical world. This will be an excellent visit for the children and of great educational value, supporting and enhancing our work in the classroom.

The children will need a packed lunch or a grab bag. Please indicate on Parentmail if they would like cheese or ham sandwich option if a grab bag is required. Your child will also need a drink.
