## Y4 Residential visit to Castleton. 19<sup>th</sup> -20<sup>th</sup> March 2026

The final balance is due by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026.

On Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March, please drop your child's suitcase off, on arrival at school at the Don Hall from 8.30am. Any medicines to be clearly labelled with your child's name and class and given to Y4 staff at the Don Hall. Children should then go round to their classroom and can enter class at 8.40 am as usual. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.15/9.30am.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink from home on their first day. All other meals are provided.

We will be visiting Treak Cliff Cavern and Castleton village on Thursday.

On Friday, children will be doing problem solving activities, orienteering and low rope activities at the Hollowford Centre for half the day and Bouldering/rocks activities in Derbyshire for half the day.

The Hollowford Centre organise these activities and take us to the activity sites in their minibuses.

Please find below a recommended list of what to bring on the visit.

Luggage should be packed in a small suitcase or sports bag.

Your child will also need a separate small rucksack which will be used to carry their lunches, waterproofs and drink.

### What to bring

- A packed lunch and drink for the first day and any spending money in a labelled purse (Maximum £5) This should be in their rucksack ready for walking.
- A complete change of outdoor, warm clothing (not best clothes) – T-shirt, sweatshirt or fleece, trousers/leggings/ joggers (preferably not jeans),
- Waterproofs – A waterproof and warm coat and waterproof trousers if you have them.
- Suitable shoes for walking, eg. walking boots or Wellingtons.
- A pair of Trainers or sensible shoes
- Slippers or pumps for indoors
- Several pairs of socks in case they get wet.
- Hat, gloves and scarf if it is cold.
- Hat and sunscreen if the forecast is sunny.
- Indoor slippers/pumps
- Pyjamas or nightie
- Bag containing soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, hairbrush etc
- Book and/or small, quiet indoor game eg Top Trumps etc.
- Favourite cuddly toy to snuggle up to.
- Torch (not essential but fun outdoors in the evening).

Children need to come to school dressed ready for the outdoors as we will be going straight outside on arrival.

Children MUST have a pair of slippers/pumps etc for indoors. This is a health and safety request from the Hollowford Centre catering team. Children have to wear indoor footwear in the cafeteria. Please no Crocs.

During the visit there will be an opportunity for children to visit a small gift shop. We would therefore ask that children bring a labelled purse/wallet with up to £5.00 but no more. It is the children's responsibility to look after their own belongings. Please label everything clearly with their full name.
