Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 Trip to Creswell Crag – Tuesday 3rd March 2026

We are writing to inform you of a planned day trip to Creswell Crag for our Year 3 students as part of our 'Stone Age' topic. During the day, children will get to learn what life would have been like in the Stone Age including clothing, tools and shelter. They will also get the chance to head deeper into caves and learn what animals they would have seen in the Stone Age. They will have a go at creating their own Stone Age shelter. They will also learn about the role of a palaeontologist and will learn about different rocks and fossils. This ties in closely to the curriculum objectives that we are covering in the classroom during the Spring Term.

The cost of the visit will be £18.98 which covers the cost of admission and transport. This must be paid online using ParentPay. Although payment for the trip is voluntary, we would appreciate your understanding that the visit can only go ahead once the full contribution has been received. Payment must be made by Sunday 1st March 2026.

All children must bring a packed lunch with a water bottle. Taylor Shaw can provide a 'Grab Bag' at the cost of £2.90, the sandwich in the lunch will be cheese or ham so please indicate your choice on ParentPay when paying.

Children will need to arrive at school at 8.30am, ready for registration, and will **return to school at approximately 3.45pm (we will dismiss them from their usual classroom door)**. They will need to dress in warm, waterproof clothes and suitable footwear for outdoor learning in March so that they can take part in the outdoor exploration and all the activities.

In order for the trip to proceed, a small number of parent volunteers will be required. Please can you let Mrs Sorsby know if you are able to help out on this trip. You can do this via ClassDojo.
