National Emergency Services Museum for Foundation Stage 2

As part of our topic next half term, 'People who help us', we have planned an exciting trip to the National Emergency Services Museum on **Thursday 19th March 2026** for both Miss Bennett's and Mrs Holmes & Mrs Lindley's Classes.

Here we will enhance and consolidate the children's personal, social and emotional development by discovering who our everyday superheroes are, learn about how the emergency services help us when we are in need, find out how, when and who to contact if an emergency occurs, as well exploring hands on exhibits including uniforms and real emergency vehicles. We are sure that this will be an excellent visit for the children and of great educational value, supporting and enhancing our work in the classroom.

We will be leaving school at 9.15am, so the children need to arrive at school at the usual time. We anticipate returning for the usual home time.

The cost of the visit is £14.25 per child, which includes coach costs, entrance fee, an educational workshop and the expertise of the museum staff. We would ask that all payments be in school by **Monday 16th March** so that we can inform the venue of our final numbers. Please pay via the Peak Edge app.

Pupils will need a back-pack to carry their lunch and a water bottle. If you would like a grab bag from school you can order one by indicating on ParentPay. Although the children will be inside the museum for most of the day, we advise that they wear a warm coat. We also ask that children wear their school uniform, so that they can be easily identified.
