Dear Parents and Carers

Yorkshire Sport Foundation, in liaison with School Games and LINKs, are hosting a **Year 4 basketball competition** to be held at Bradfield Secondary School on **Monday 9th February 2026 – 3.45pm to 4.45pm** and your child may express an interest in representing the school at this event. This event is the beginning of a competitive pathway, and may lead to a forthcoming 'finals' event, to be held later in the year. We are restricted to a maximum of 5 boys and 5 girls at this event so, in the likely event that the team is oversubscribed, names will be selected and families will be informed as to whether or not their child has secured a place on this occasion.

Children will need to be transported to Bradfield School and we ask for your support in arranging transport for your child both to and from the event. Parents may wish to organise travel in groups but we kindly request this is done between parents. We ask that you leave school as soon as you have collected your child and make your way to the Sports Hall at Bradfield to allow for a prompt start where possible. Parents/carers are welcome to stay and spectate at this event if they like, or children can be dropped off and collected. In either situation, children should make themselves known to OPS school staff at the start of the event. If you are not staying at Bradfield with us, we ask that children are collected **promptly** at 4.45pm.

Children should wear their school PE kit where possible (including appropriate indoor shoes to wear on the sports hall floor), and bring a named water bottle with them.

The main aims of the evening are to develop children's teamwork, throwing and catching skills, and to provide them with the opportunity to represent Oughtibridge Primary School in a sporting environment. It will also give them the opportunity to meet and mix with children from other schools within our local cluster.

If your child is interested, please can this slip be returned to Mr Butler via the School Office ASAP, and no later than **Friday 16th January**.
