England's target for 'free sugar' intake for your child
Recommended fruit and vegetable portion sizes are calculated using School Food Standards.
On average our desserts do not exceed a third of a child's recommended 'free sugar' intake.

The school receives additional money for every child that has a school dinner on this day.

If your child is in **FS2, Year 1, or Year 2, or qualifies for income-based Free School Meals**, we'd really appreciate it if they could have a school meal on that day. This is because the number of children having a school lunch on Census Day has a big impact on the funding our school receives. The more children in these year groups that take up a school lunch, the more support we get for the school. To help encourage as many children as possible to join in, we'll be running Lucky Plates – where a few lucky children will receive a special treat just for having school lunch! If your child usually brings a packed lunch, they're still welcome to bring it as a backup, but we'd love them to give a hot meal a try on the day. Thanks so much for your support – it really does make a difference.

Also note due to delivery difficulties a change to Monday's usual menu.

This workshop will focus on the importance of good quality sleep and how it can impact your well being. Providing practical strategies that you can try at home to support your child with sleep.


