## Year 3 - Hallé for Youth Orchestra Concert Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that Year 3 pupils will be attending a live concert performed by the Hallé for Youth Orchestra on **Friday 6th March 2026** at Sheffield City Hall. This trip supports our aim to provide all children with opportunities to experience high-quality live music.

The concert introduces children to the sounds of a full symphony orchestra, with live footage shown on a large screen so instruments can be seen clearly. This year's performance is themed around International Women's Day, celebrating women's achievements and promoting equality through music. As part of the experience, children will learn a song in school and perform it during the concert.

The cost of the trip is a voluntary contribution of **£13.70**, which covers the concert ticket, coach travel, and insurance. We would appreciate contributions being made as early as possible to help with organisation; however, the final deadline for payment via ParentPay is **Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March**. If you require extra time for payment, please contact the school office.

The concert is scheduled to finish at around midday. To keep them energised during the morning, children **may bring a healthy snack in their coat pocket** to eat before the concert. We will eat lunch once we return to school, so **your child will need a healthy packed lunch** for the day. If you would like a grab bag from school you can order one by indicating on ParentPay. In addition to this, your child will need to bring a waterproof coat and a backpack which will fit your child's packed lunch and water bottle in.

Photographs and video footage may be taken during the concert, including occasional shots of the audience shown live on screen. If you have any concerns, please contact the school office or your child's class teacher.

We will require a small number of parent volunteers for this trip. **If you are able to assist on this trip, please inform the class teacher via Class Dojo.** Should we have too many parent volunteers, names will be selected and all volunteers will be informed in a timely manner.
