Thanks to our partnership with Sheffield Hatters, who recently delivered some basketball coaching to our classes, we have been invited to a **Year 5 basketball competition** to be held at Canon Medical Arena on **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March, between 12.30pm and 3.00pm**. We are restricted to a maximum of 6 boys and 6 girls at this event so, in the likely event that the team is oversubscribed, names will be selected and families will be informed as to whether or not their child has secured a place on this occasion.

Children will be transported to this event by minibus, and accompanied by Mr Butler at the event. We will require a further one additional volunteer to help us to run this trip. If you are able to join us, please indicate on the slip below ASAP and Mr Butler will be in touch should we require your support.

As mentioned, we will travel by minibus for this event, leaving Oughtibridge School at 11.45am, and returning to school for approximately 3.45pm. When we return to school, children will be dismissed from their classrooms. Due to the fact that we are returning after the end of the school day, children **MUST** be collected by an adult. This event is free to children as our entry fee and transport costs are covered by the school's Sports Premium budget for 2025/26.

Children attending this event should wear their school PE kit to the tournament (including appropriate indoor shoes to wear on the basketball court), and bring a named water bottle with them. The Sheffield Hatters have very kindly confirmed that they will provide the children with a further commemorative shirt at the event to play in. Otherwise, children are welcome to come to school in their PE kit, ready for the event. Children will also need a packed lunch to eat before the event, as we will be eating before the start of normal lunch service.
