Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach our Year 3 residential on **Tuesday 14th – Wednesday 15th April**, we wanted to share some final information to ensure everything runs smoothly. Please also find attached a copy of the PowerPoint the children were shown this week with further information.

Pick Up and Drop Off:

The children should arrive at school at the normal time on Tuesday and go straight to their classroom as usual. If the weather is dry, you will be directed to leave suitcases/bags outside the classroom.

We will return to school on Wednesday afternoon and children will be ready to be collected as normal at the end of the school day.

Please note that any medicines must be labelled and handed to your child's class teacher on the morning of the day of departure.

Q&A Drop In

Class teachers will be available for a drop-in Q&A session on **Tuesday 24th March from 3:30–4:00pm in Y3DH** if you would like to discuss anything in person. This is not a compulsory meeting and no new information will be delivered. This is merely an opportunity to talk through any arising issues with staff prior to the residential.





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What to Bring:

Please find below a recommended list of what to bring on the visit. Luggage should be packed in a small suitcase or sports bag that they can carry themselves (they need to get it to and from the coach at each end). Your child may bring a separate small rucksack which will be used to carry a jumper/coat, drink and book or small activity for the coach.

Essential items:

- Outdoor clothing (wear one set on Tuesday and pack a complete change of clothes for Wednesday)
- A warm jumper (even if it's warm weather during the day)
- Pyjamas
- An extra pair of socks (these often go missing!)
- A bag for dirty clothes
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, facecloth, hairbrush, etc.)
- Indoor shoes or slippers
- Sturdy footwear (trainers or walking boots – these may get muddy)
- A hat and sun cream (fingers crossed for good weather!)
- A water bottle
- A packed lunch for the first day
- A coat

Waterproofs and wellies will be provided by the centre if the weather means they are necessary.

Optional:

- A book, colouring, card game or quiet activity for the coach journey and early mornings
- A cuddly toy
- A small bedside clock or simple watch (nothing smart or expensive)
- A torch
- Cash for the gift shop (coins only, max £3)

Please note:

- Everything needs to be named!
- **No electronics, phones, cameras, or valuables** should be brought.
- School cannot take responsibility for any lost items. If you're worried it could get lost, don't bring it!
