SATS Week

SATs start on Monday 11th May. The children will carry out a series of tests throughout the week:

- Monday 11th May: Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (45 minutes and 15 minutes)
- Tuesday 12th May: Reading Comprehension (1 hour)
- Wednesday 13th May: Maths Paper 1 – Arithmetic (30 minutes); Maths Paper 2 – Reasoning (40 minutes)
- Thursday 14th May: Maths Paper 3: Reasoning (40 minutes)

Both the children, and staff, have been working extremely hard to prepare for the tests and would like to ask for your help to ensure that they do as well as possible.

Getting a good sleep every night is especially important. With this in mind, we would like to request that your child is in bed at a reasonable time - both in the run-up and the actual week of the tests - and has had a hearty breakfast! The children need to be at school promptly at 8:30am, each morning, as we will begin with a 'warm up'.

With this being said, we would like the children to come to school at 8.30am each day. Please can the Y6 children come straight to their classroom door as soon as they arrive. Please note, we will ensure the gates are open at this time for pupils to enter the school grounds.

Should your child feel unwell on the day (nerves may make them feel unwell), it is vital you contact the school so arrangements can be made to ensure your child is still able to take the test.

We are all immensely proud of the children: the way in which they have focussed on their learning; the determination to succeed that they have shown and the sheer hard work they have put in. All the children have made excellent progress and are poised to do very well.
