Update: Our Digital Medical Tracker

We are pleased to share that our new **digital medical tracker** has been live for a few weeks now. This system replaced our traditional paper "bump notes" with direct email notifications, and we hope you've found this transition to be a more efficient way of staying informed about your child's well-being.

What to Expect

As children are often active and adventurous during break times, it is perfectly normal for them to experience occasional minor bumps and scrapes. Because of this:

- **Frequency:** You may notice several notifications in a single week. This is simply a reflection of an active school life!
- **Documentation:** We record every incident—no matter how small—to ensure your child's school health record is thorough and up-to-date.
- **Peace of Mind:** Please rest assured that the vast majority of these incidents are very minor and require no further action.

Our Communication Promise

While the email system is excellent for routine updates, our priority is always your child's safety. **In the event of a more serious incident or injury, we will always contact you via telephone immediately.**
