Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our wider learning in the Summer Term, we have arranged a trip to Yorkshire Sculpture Park on **Friday 19th June**. We will link our visit into our Art topic for the Summer, which focuses on 'Sculptures'. As part of our visit, children will undertake a guided tour of the park called "Walk, Talk, Make" to look at the range of art installations on site. We will also eat lunch together at the Park.

The cost of the visit will be a voluntary contribution of £18.80 and this includes entry to Yorkshire Sculpture Park, the cost of the workshop, coach hire and relevant insurances. This payment must be made using the Peak Edge app prior to the deadline of **Friday 5th June**. In the event that we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, it may be that we are unable to facilitate this trip.

Your child will need a healthy packed lunch for the day. If you would like a grab bag from school you can order one by indicating on the Peak Edge app. In addition to this, your child will need to bring a waterproof coat and a backpack which will fit your child's packed lunch and water bottle in as they will be expected to carry their lunch with them throughout the day. Children can attend in any comfortable, sensible outdoor shoes. If the weather is pleasant, children may require suncream or other protection from the heat.

On the day of the trip, please can children be dropped off at school at 8.30am, so that we can register prior to our coach pickup at 9am. We are aiming to return to school in time for the normal end of the school day.

We will require a small number of parent volunteers for this trip. If you are able to assist with this trip, please inform class teachers via ClassDojo as soon as possible so that our risk assessment can be updated promptly.
