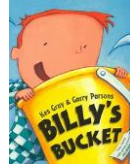


Our topic is...

I Wonder what's by the Seaside?

English

We will be reading and writing about the story Billy's Bucket. We will also be writing about our experience of seeing and holding animals in the touch tank.



Mathematics

We are continuing to follow NCETM maths and will be using Rekenrek is subitise numbers. We will also revisit counting and comparing numbers ready for Year 1.



In Reading this term the children will be reading Super Stories. We will choose one story each week and look closely at the background knowledge around the story, the vocabulary and then what happens in the story. This is early years reading comprehension.

In Phonics this term we will be continuing to learn and consolidate our special friends knowledge. We will be applying our sound knowledge into reading words, simple phrases and short sentences.

Seaside Day

Towards the end of this half term we are going to hold a 'seaside day' at school, where we turn our classrooms and playground into the seaside. It is lots of fun!

Foundation Subjects

We will be sharing our experiences of the seaside and thinking about how this has changed over the years. We will support this learning with a Seaside Day in school.
