Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Art Curriculum this term, we are exploring architecture from around the world, focusing on buildings with different shapes, sizes, and unusual or creative designs. During the trip, the children will observe and sketch a variety of buildings in the city centre, including well-known structures such as The Egg Box (Sheffield Town Hall Extension), The Winter Gardens, and Sheffield Hallam University Student Union, along with several others. These sketches will help inspire their own building designs, which they will later create and draw in their sketchbooks back at school. We will also be taking part in a clay sculpture workshop at the Millennium Galleries. This will focus on shapes and textures that the children will have observed on the buildings.

The trip will take place on Tuesday 6th October 2026. The children will be travelling by coach. They will be leaving school at 9:30am and will return at around 2:30pm. This means children will need to be dropped off and picked up as normal. All children will need a packed lunch and a drink, along with a waterproof coat. Children should be in school uniform.

A voluntary contribution of £14.13. per child is requested to cover the cost of the trip. Payment should be made via the 'Peak Edge App'. You are also able to order a Grab Bag from Taylor Shaw at the cost of £3.00. Please indicate whether you would like ham or cheese, when ordering. The deadline for payments is **Friday 25th September**.
