Earth and Space!



English

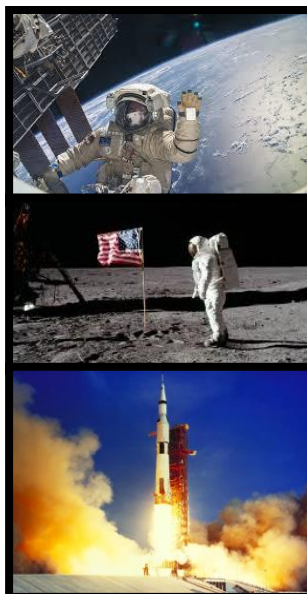
In English this half term, we will be creating historical recounts of the first moon landing in 1969. Through immersing ourselves in video clips, interviews and articles, we will build a bank of information before reporting this to readers.

Later in the Autumn Term, we will use clips of the imaginary planet of Pandora to compose some creative writing. Towards Christmas, we will write letters to 'the man on the moon'.

Mathematics

Children will spend time in the Autumn Term looking at the four operations, before taking our first Year 5 look at Fractions.

In Year 5, children will be working with numbers to 1,000,000 and will begin the year with a block looking at the value of numbers to one million, and their place on the number line.



In Science this term the children will be spending Autumn 1 looking at Earth and Space. This will include a dive into the planets in our Solar System, the Moon, and how day, night and time is dictated.

After the October half term, our focus turns to Forces. This will include gravity, air and water resistance, and friction.

In Computing this term we will be focusing on Computer Systems and Networks. This will consider how computerised systems connect to one another, and the users that are supported by them.

In Autumn 2, a media unit will focus on Video Production.
